Administration Report:

Renee Pick:

- We have new student teachers joining us after spring break.
- Bike lessons coming in May for grade 4/5 students are put on by Bike Hub.
- PAC Funds have been used for the whole school: Arts Reach, Gymnastics, Naden Band busses, Story Theatre
- Food rations in emergency bins expire in October 2020. We are getting quotes from a few different companies.
One company is based on the mainland and prepares food fresh to order. These products will last 5 years from date made. We can either purchase smaller portions each year for 3 years, to keep more fresh food on hand, or a one time order that will last 5 years. We will continue to collect quotes and make a decision in the coming months.
- Mandy will contact Troy Mollin from View Royal Fire to make a plan for our safety containers, and to see if there is a grant available to schools for purchase of such supplies.
